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15 NIGHTS PERTH - ADELAIDE

Our 15-night journey from Perth to Adelaide showcases the very best of Australia's southern coastline, blending rugged landscapes with unforgettable coastal beauty. Discover Albany and the moving National ANZAC Centre, stand above the crashing seas at The Gap at Torndirrup National Park, and explore the pristine beaches of Esperance, including Cape Le Grand National Park and Lucky Bay. A peaceful cruise along the Kalgan River adds a relaxing highlight.

Travel inland to Fraser Range Station before crossing the vast Nullarbor Plain, where endless horizons meet the dramatic cliffs of the Great Australian Bight. Discover hidden gems including Murrawijinie Caves, Madura Cave and the Historic Koonalda Homestead, offering a glimpse into the region's unique natural and cultural heritage. On the Eyre Peninsula, enjoy scenic drives through Streaky Bay and along the Elliston Cliff Top Drive, visit Murphy's Haystacks, and indulge in fresh seafood experiences in Port Lincoln and Coffin Bay Oyster Farm. Continue to Australian Arid Lands Botanic Garden and historic Bungaree Station, before unwinding in the Clare Valley with a winery lunch and wine tasting to finish this remarkable journey.

ITINERARY - PERTH - ADELAIDE

Day 1 | Overnight in Perth

The tour will officially kick off at the hotel's restaurant at 6:30 PM, where you will enjoy a welcome drink and dinner. This is also a great opportunity to meet your fellow travellers and the Kimberley Outback Tours crew.

Day 2 | Perth to Albany

Depart Perth and journey south through rolling farmland to the charming rural town of Williams, before continuing to the historic coastal city of Albany. From here, explore the dramatic coastline of Torndirrup National Park, where rugged cliffs, powerful Southern Ocean swells, and striking natural formations create an unforgettable introduction to the region. Later, settle into your accommodation in Albany for a relaxing two-night stay. En-suited Hotel Room - Hilton Garden Inn, Albany (B,L,D)

Day 3 | Exploring Albany

Today begins with a relaxing cruise along the tranquil Kalbar River aboard the Kalbar Queen, where you'll enjoy scenic waterways, abundant birdlife, and engaging local commentary. After lunch, choose between a visit to the award-winning National ANZAC Centre for a moving insight into Australia's military history, or explore the Museum of the Great Southern, home to fascinating regional stories and the historic Brig Amity replica. Day 4 | Albany to Esperance via Fitzgerald National Park

Depart Albany and journey east along a scenic coastal route to Esperance, travelling via the charming town of Hopetoun. Along the way, explore the diverse landscapes of Fitzgerald River National Park, renowned for its rugged coastline, unique wildflowers, and sweeping ocean views, offering a memorable day of natural beauty before arriving in Esperance.

Day 5 | Woody Island Day Tour

Day 6 | Esperance to Fraser Range Station via Cape Le Grand

Continuing inland, we travel through the vast Wheatbelt region to Norseman, gateway to the outback, before crossing the ancient landscapes of the Great Western Woodlands. Day 7 | 90 Mile Straight to the Nullarbor

Today is a big day on the road as we journey east across the vast Nullarbor Plain toward the South Australian border. Travel along the iconic 90 Mile Straight—Australia's longest straight stretch of road—before stopping to explore the fascinating caves near Madura. As the landscape opens up, enjoy your first glimpse of the sweeping blue horizons that define this remarkable and remote region.

Day 8 | Nullarbor Plain and Great Australian Bight

Today we cross the border into South Australia and journey deep into the legendary Nullarbor Plain, a land of endless horizons, wide-open skies, and stark, unforgettable beauty. Along the way, visit the historic Koonalda Station, then be awed by the sheer cliffs of the Great Australian Bight, where the thundering Southern Ocean gives a breathtaking sense of standing at the very edge of the continent. Keep an eye out for dingoes and the occasional wombat hole as you traverse this extraordinary landscape. At the end of the day, explore the fascinating Murrawijinie Caves and the rock paintings of the Mirning people. We settle into the iconic Nullarbor Roadhouse.

Day 9 | Great Australian Bight to Streaky Bay

Today we leave the vast Nullarbor Plain, but not before one final awe-inspiring stop at the Head of the Bight, where you can take in the sweeping vistas of the Great Australian Bight one last time, feeling the drama and scale of this spectacular coastline. From here, we journey back through the rich and diverse landscapes of the Eyre Peninsula, pristine beaches, and delicious fresh seafood. Our day concludes with arrival at Streaky Bay for a relaxing two-night stay, where coastal charm and tranquil surroundings provide the perfect opportunity to unwind. Day 10 | Streaky Bay and Surrounds

This morning we set off on scenic drives along the rugged Eyre Peninsula coastline, taking in the dramatic seascapes, windswept cliffs, and panoramic ocean views that define this spectacular region. Along the way, we visit Baird Bay and Labatt Point, home to one of the mainland's largest Australian Sea lion colonies. We also visit the striking ancient granite formations of Murphy's Haystacks. Day 11 | Streaky Bay to Port Lincoln via Coffin Bay

Starting from Streaky Bay, take the coastal route south along the Flinders Highway, stopping at Elliston to explore its dramatic clifftop drives, where rugged cliffs and panoramic ocean views make for perfect photo opportunities. From there, we continue down to Coffin Bay, where we will put on our waders and enjoy a hands-on oyster farm tour, wading into the waters to learn about oyster cultivation and tasting the region's famed fresh oysters. After the tour, it's a short drive to Port Lincoln, where you can settle in for our two night stay.

Day 12 | Port Lincoln Seafood Day

Day 14 | Southern Flinders Ranges and Clare Valley

From there, we drive into the Southern Flinders Ranges, taking in spectacular views of Mount Remarkable and enjoying a short, scenic walk to stretch our legs.
